## Automatic Extension of Visa Validity

If a student's or scholar's visa expires while he or she is in the United States, or if a person changes status to F ostatus in the United States, the next time they travel abroad they must obtain a new visa in the proper category in order to be readmitted to the United States.

An exception to this rule exists for nonimmigrants (in "ac'tiFeor J status) who travel for less than 30 days solely to Canada, Mexico or "adjacent islands other than 'Outbeav'isas of such nonimmigrants are considered to be "extended" to the dateeoft right eliminating the need to obtain a new visa at a U.S. consulate before that partire datry. 22 CFR 41.112(d)

Citizens from Syria, Sudan, and Iran are not eligible for the Automation Exon of Validity

To qualify for Automatic Extension of the Validity of the visa, F and J visa holders must have the following:

An unexpired passport

An I -20 (for F status) or D2019 (for J status) endorsed for travel

An expired visa stamp(If the expired visa stamp is in an expl passport, that passport and visa stamp must also be presented upon reentry to the QRS.)

Evidence of an USCIS approved change of status, (e79,71A and/or 194 card)

I-94 marked D/S (Do not give uppyr I-94 when you leave the U.S.!)

Have not applied for a new visa during this particular trip

Has maintained and intends to resume nonimmigrant status.

You must keep your I-94 card (if applicable) upon exiting the U.S., it should NOTbe collectedfrom you.
