About:

The John G. Tower Center offers research fellowships to SMU undergraduate students that emphasize ability and interest in research on public policy, government, and international affairs. Successful applicants will work closely with SMU faculty in developing a research project, and will be introduced to substantive issues, appropriate research methodologies and techniques, research design, and theory development.

<u>Funding</u>: Each fellow will receive a **stipend of \$5,000**, **distributed in 4 equal sums over the course of 2 years**.

The fellow will be designated as one of four undergraduate fellowships:

- Edwin L. Cox Fellowship
- Al G. Hill, Jr. Fellowship
- Tom Bryant Medders, Jr. Fellowship
- Henry S. Miller Fellowship

Continuation of the stipend will depend upon satisfactory performance and progress on the research project.
