



**Domestic Violence** 

family ordenestic violence laws of the jurisdiction receiving grant funding and, in the case of victims ervices, includes the use or attempted use of physical abuse or sexual abuse, or a pattern of any other coercive behavior committed, enabled, or solicited to gain or maintain power and control over a victim including verbal, psychological, economic, or technological abuse that may or may not constitute or initial behavior;


