If your category has several Judging Teams

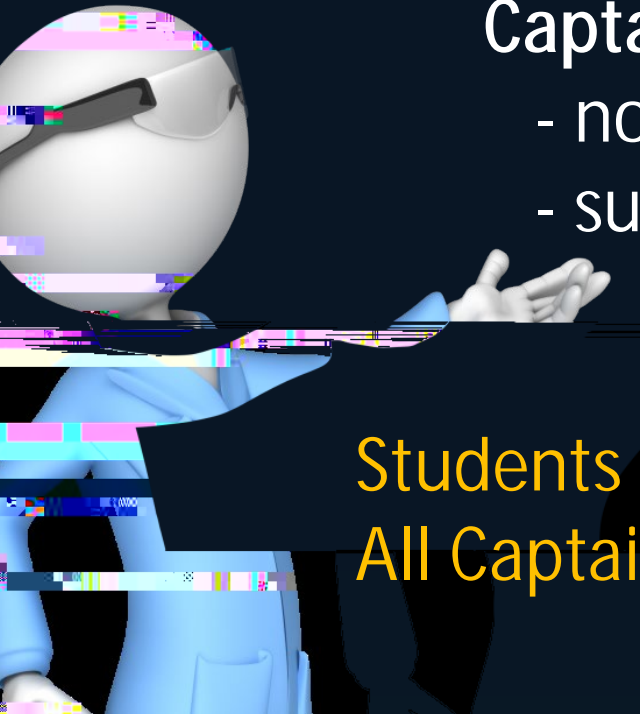
Captains submit a **BLUE** worksheet to check-in

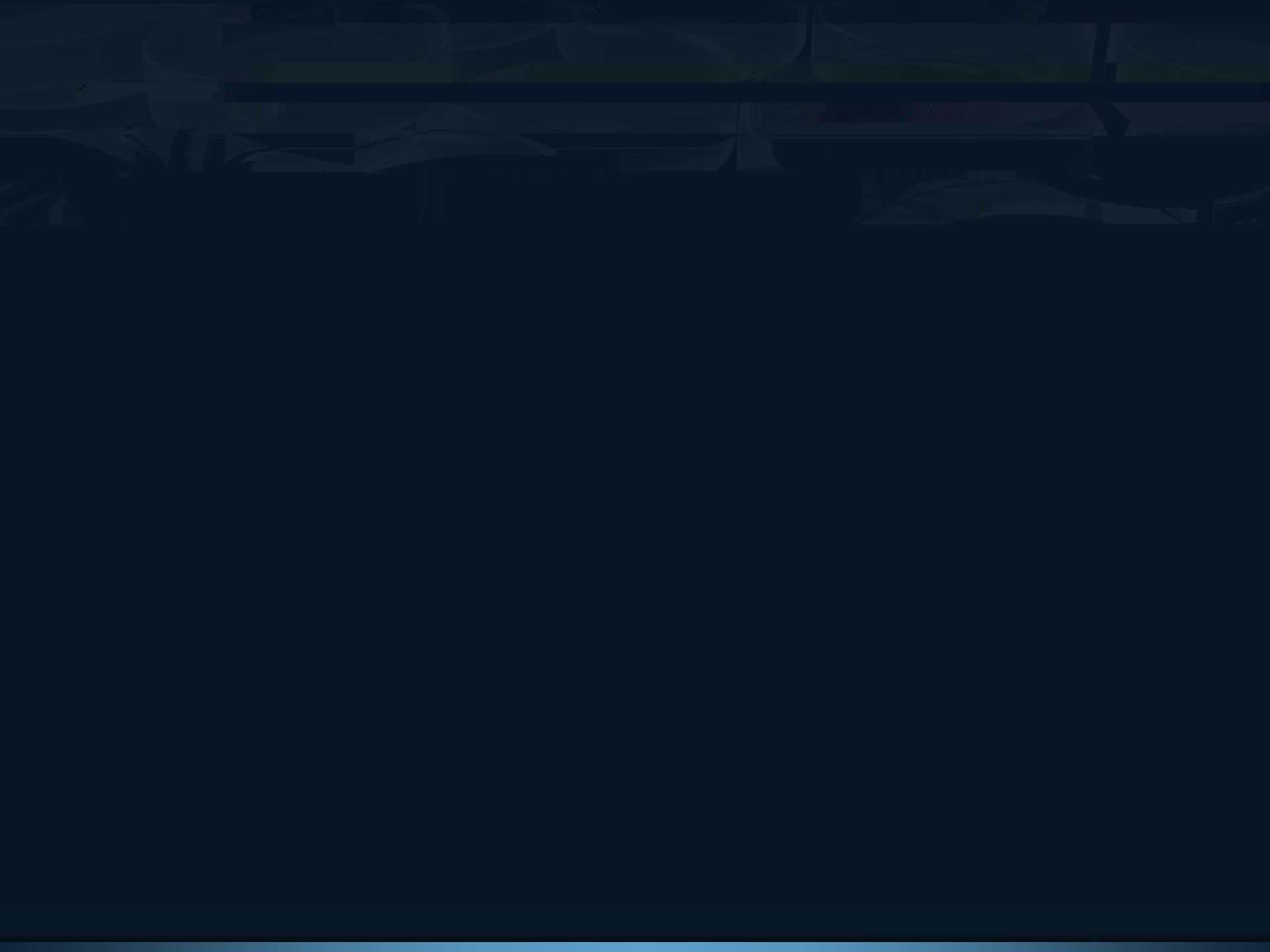
- note top 3 projects in group

- suggest Honorable Mentions

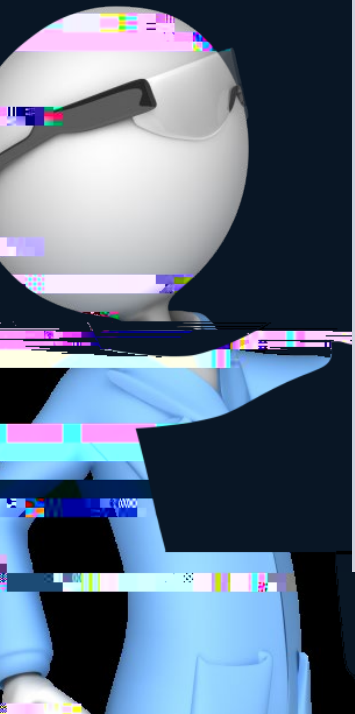
Students are dismissed at Noon.

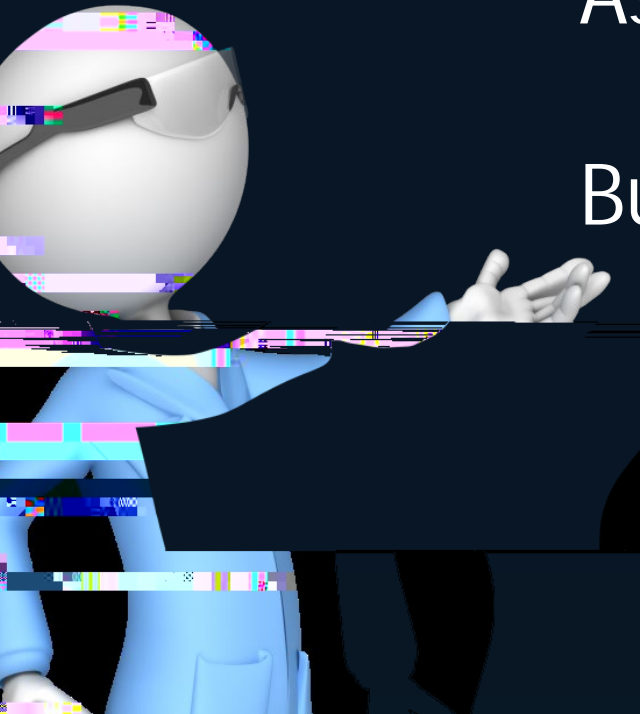
Each Judge interviews *every* project in group

Only one Judge at a project at a time

Ask many and detailed questions

Budget 8-10 min for each project

Complete evaluations *away*  
from the student



Divide your Team's projects into sub-blocks

After interview - fill out form, move to next person in block, rotate to the next block



Check mid morning to make sure all projects will be covered.

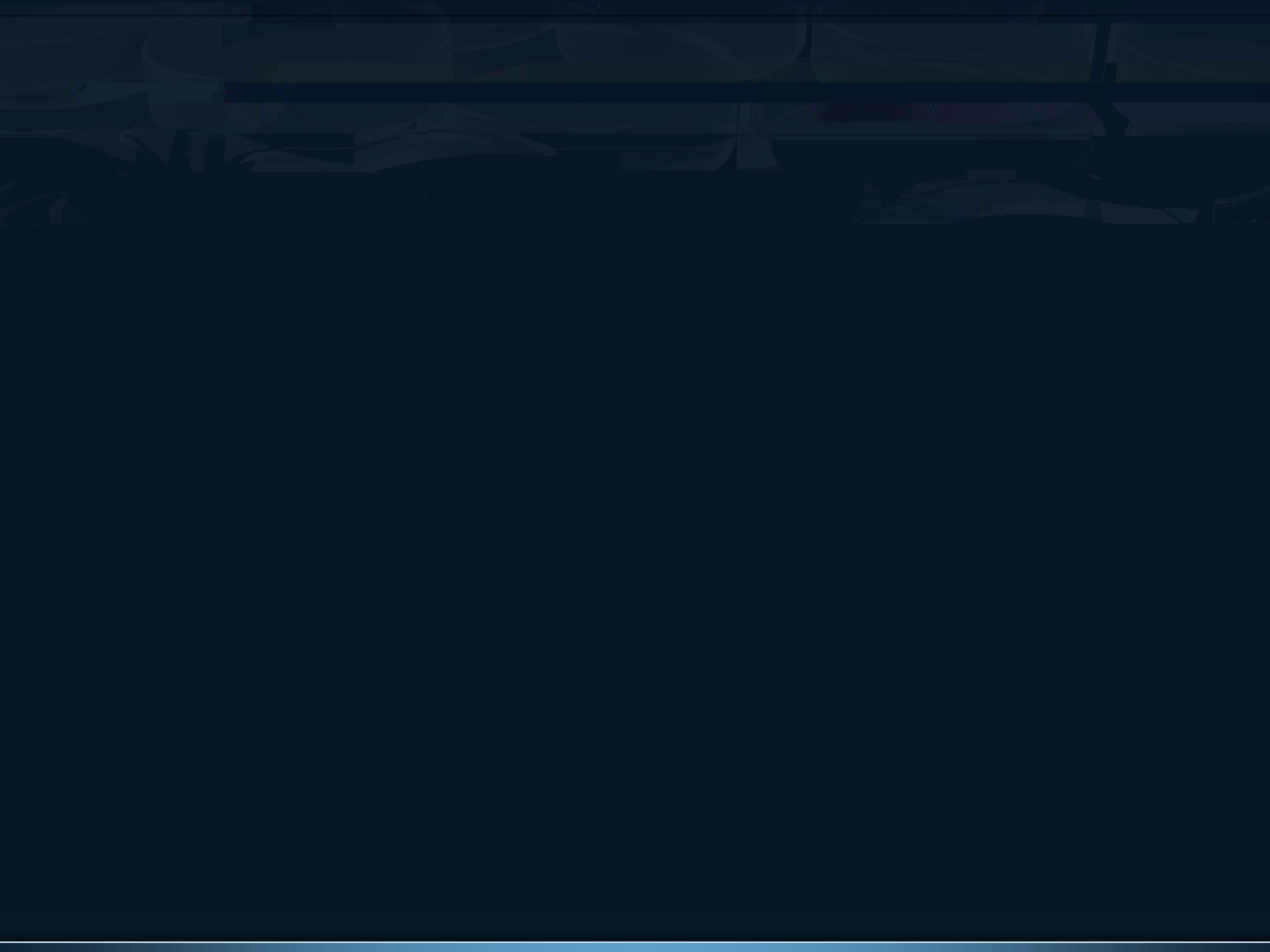
